*I'll be very greatly obliged indeed if you will use these stamps to send me a copy of next Saturday's Commercial Advertiser—supplement and all. I want to see one.*

*I found those pictures—safely put away in an envelope in the drawer of my dresser.*

*The N.Y.C. train was 1 ½ hours late this morning and my connection for the west was demoralized. It cost me 24 hours time! I got this far on a local and have to stay over. I saw some very picturesque places to day and some very picturesque Frenchy characters. I wished you were along. Had a chance to buy a steamer pass, Montreal to Toronto for \$150. Then I wished harder than ever you were here for a trip through the 1000 Islands.*
